Those candidates who are included in the above lists are hereby directed to **report in person** on the date, time and venue mentioned, along with the following original documents and admission fee. The candidate should produce all the original documents required by the University for verification purpose at the time of admission or a stipulated time frame for producing the same in the case of 2025 passed out applicants failing which, their candidature for admission will be forfeited and admission shall be cancelled at any stage. No further claim in this regard will be entertained.


1. Proof of Date of Birth – Birth certificate/ Class X Certificate.
2. All Certificates and Mark sheets/ Grade reports, related to Class X and Class XII
3. Final Mark lists/ Grade reports and UG/PG Degree Certificates from the concerned University
4. Physical Fitness Certificate issued by Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon.
5. Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (NCLC) in case of reservation candidates under SEBC (Ezhavas, Muslims, OBH, LC/AI, Dheevera, Viswakarma, Other Backward Christians etc.). Non-Keralite applicants are not eligible for caste reservation.
6. Community Certificate (for SC/ST candidates). Non-Keralite applicants are not eligible for communal reservation.
7. Medical certificate issued by the competent authority in the case of Differently abled (DA) candidates.
8. Character / Conduct certificate (original) from the Head of the Institution last studied.
9. Original Transfer Certificate (to be submitted within 3 working days, only after confirming admission)
10. Migration certificate (original)
11. Aadhaar Card
12. Income and Asset Certificate (for Economically Weaker Section candidates) (original).
13. Nativity Certificate

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 - Candidates are directed to keep sufficient photocopies of each certificate mentioned above with them at the time of admission.
 - **Admission fee** as specified in the Prospectus of the related course is to be remitted by all the candidates at the time of admission. Admission fee is Non Refundable. **(Fee is collected by UPI/QR code)**
 - The semester fee is to be remitted at the allotted institution at the time of registration of semester.
 - Candidates who fail to report in person for admission along with the documents as specified above or fail to remit the admission fee at the time of admission will lose their chance for admission without assigning any reason or any further notice. In such cases, next eligible candidates from the list will be given admission according to the rank and the reservation. No further claim in this regard will be entertained.

Attention

- **This call to attend admission alone does not confers the candidates any right for admission/seat. The admission will be strictly based on the vacancy of seats, academic merit, reservation criteria and submission of certificates at sanctioned time.**
- **Seats unavailed by the reservation categories will be filled from eligible General category at the time of admission.**

Note: This admission is under RF mode and hence, fee concession is not available to the candidates enjoying communal reservation
