The same will be accepted by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of the Dean of faculty (Agril.Engg.), KCAET, Tavanur payable at SBI, Kuttippuram and should be sent separately along with the tender. EMD at 1% of the cost of equipment including GST (subject to minimum of Rs. 1500) offered should be remitted by a separate DD drawn as detailed above.
2. An agreement in Kerala stamp paper worth Rs. 200/- should also be enclosed. (Form of agreement can be downloaded from the website <http://www.kau.edu/tenders> under the related document section).
